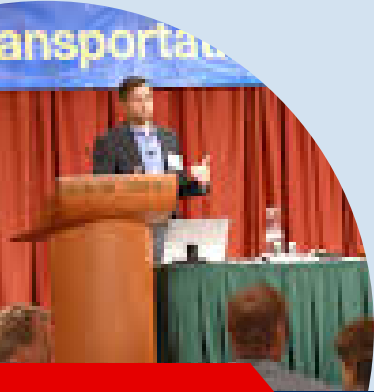

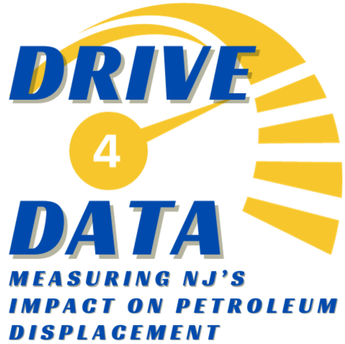

## Green Tie *gala* CLEAN AIR FUNDRAISER

# FUNDING & RESOURCES



## Funding Available for Local Government On-Road Medium & Heavy-Duty Vehicle Electrification

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) continues to provide funding to electrify local government medium- and heavy-duty diesel vehicles, reinforcing New Jersey's dedication to reducing diesel emissions, combating climate change and improving air quality and public health. Eligible local governments are encouraged to apply for this first-come, first-served basis to electrify their fleets and help create a cleaner New Jersey.

### Project Eligibility

Local government vehicles including but not limited to: shuttles, transit buses, garbage trucks, dump trucks, and small Type A/B school buses. Type C/D school buses will be funded by the Electric School Bus program, the third and final round, which is expected to open Summer 2026.

Vehicle(s) being replaced must be decommissioned. Photographic proof of decommissioning must be submitted to the DEP, including: photos of a 3" x 3" hole in the engine block, the chassis cut in half, a clear photo of the VIN and Engine Data Plate, and more. The funded vehicles will be required to have a state-supplied telematic device installed for a period of three (3) years.

This is a reimbursement program. Projects are eligible for advance payments, but final payments will not be disbursed until all vehicles/equipment are delivered and operable and proof of decommission of old vehicles/equipment has been submitted.

Awards will be flat incentive amounts based on vehicle type and class. Additional incentive amounts are available for overburdened communities (OBC) and small governments. The amounts are designed to reflect the approximate incremental cost between a new electric vehicle and a new diesel vehicle plus the cost of a charging station. Incentive amount will be reduced if it exceeds the cost of the new electric vehicle.
